



Conocimiento - What does it mean?

Comes from the word *conocer*, which means getting acquainted

When people get acquainted, they create connection

Part of 4 core steps in family activism

Conocimiento – Why is it important?

Conocimiento is knowing someone in a way in which you can better support them

Continuous knowing creates stronger connection

There is more power in relationships where we are connected





Conocimiento - How is it culturally grounded?

There is an emotional and social connection to culture

Based on sharing conversation and storytelling
Strong focus on family

Conocimiento – How does it relate to family engagement?

Enhances your ability to increase family interconnection, unity & power

Creates a better community where supporting each other is desired and comes easily






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Conocimiento in Family Engagement Activities








Process used co-powering communication resulting in program model used in our first year (pre-pilot)




