College Credit Plus

- **What is College Credit Plus?**
 - Ohio General Assembly legislation began with 2015-2016 school year
 - All dual enrollment for Ohio students must follow College Credit Plus requirements



College Credit Plus

- **What is College Credit Plus?**
 - Ohio's dual enrollment program for students in grades 7 through 12
 - Students:
 - Can attend a public college or university with no tuition charge to the student
 - Can attend a participating private colleges and may incur a cost per credit hour



College Credit Plus

- **What is College Credit Plus?**
 - Students:
 - Must complete an assessment exam and be determined “eligible” to participate
 - Must be admitted to the college or university
 - May choose from a variety of college-level courses as determined by placement testing and college prerequisites
 - Must be Ohio residents



College Credit Plus

- **What is College Credit Plus?**
 - Students:
 - May take up to 30 credits per year
 - May enroll at more than one institution of higher education
 - May take courses at the high school, at the college campus, or online

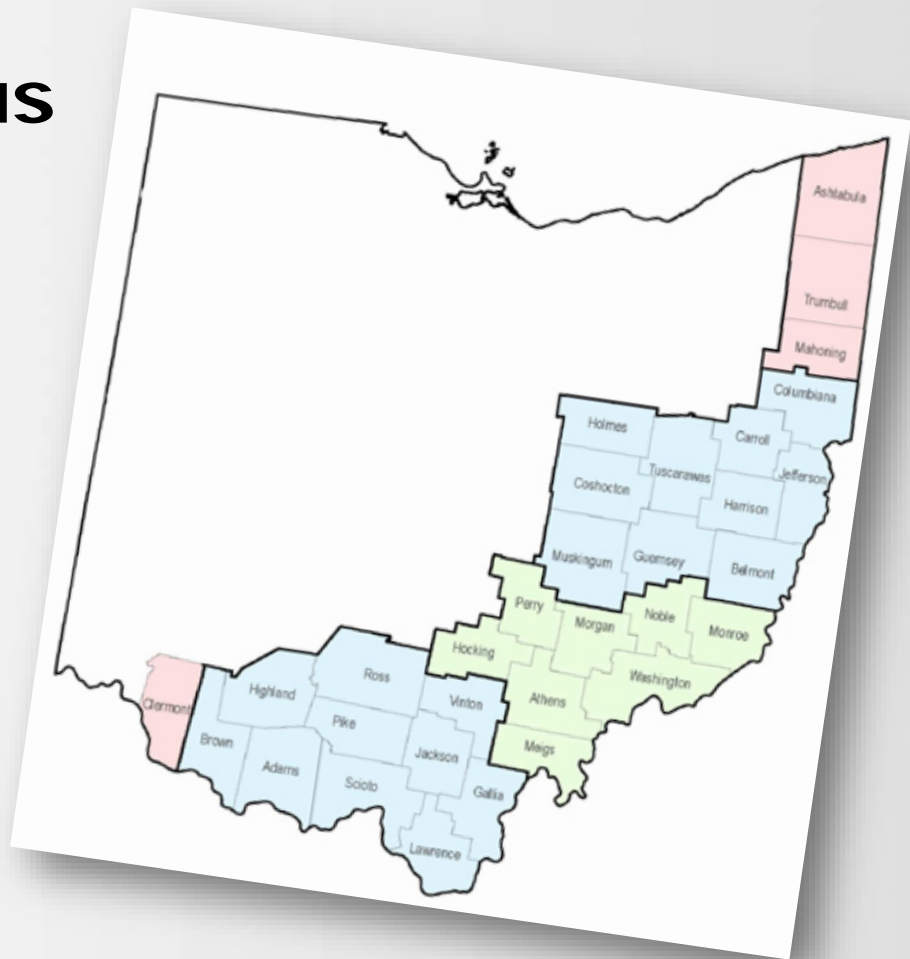

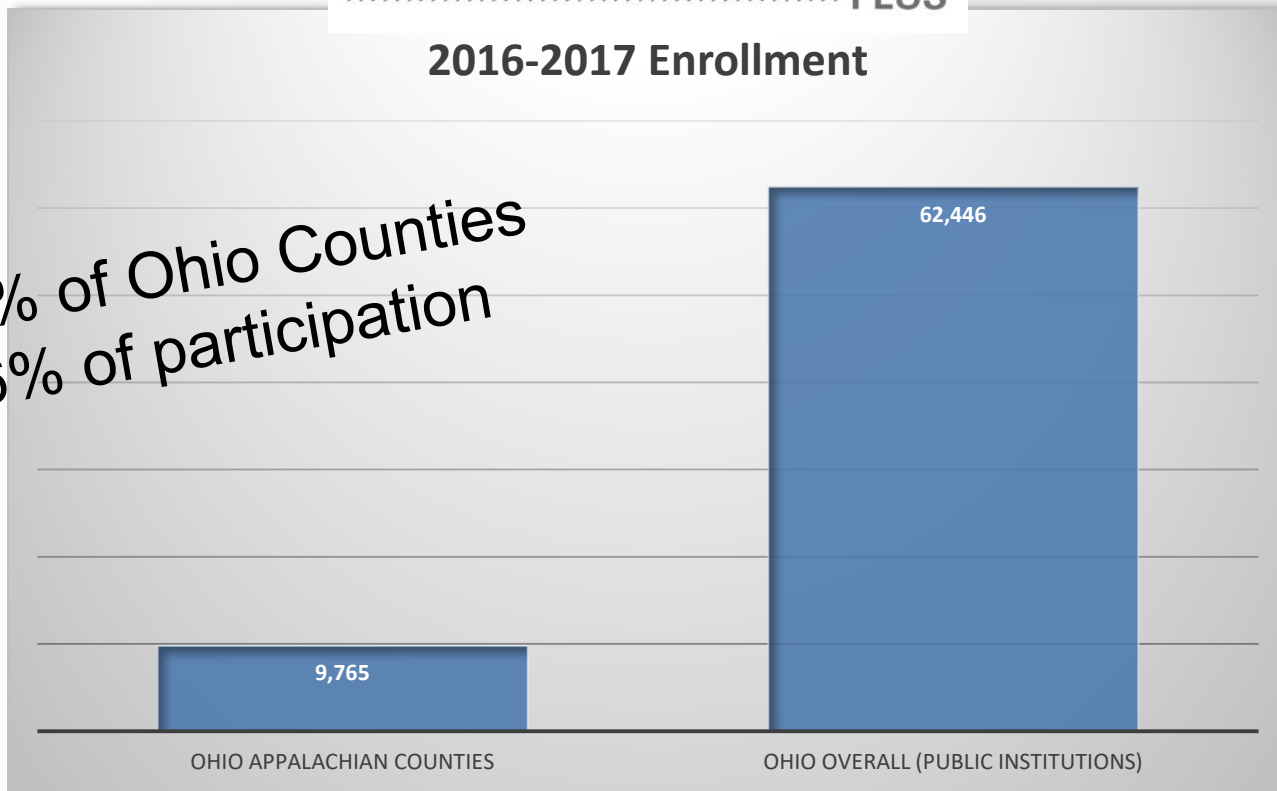




CollegeCredit PLUS

6% of participation



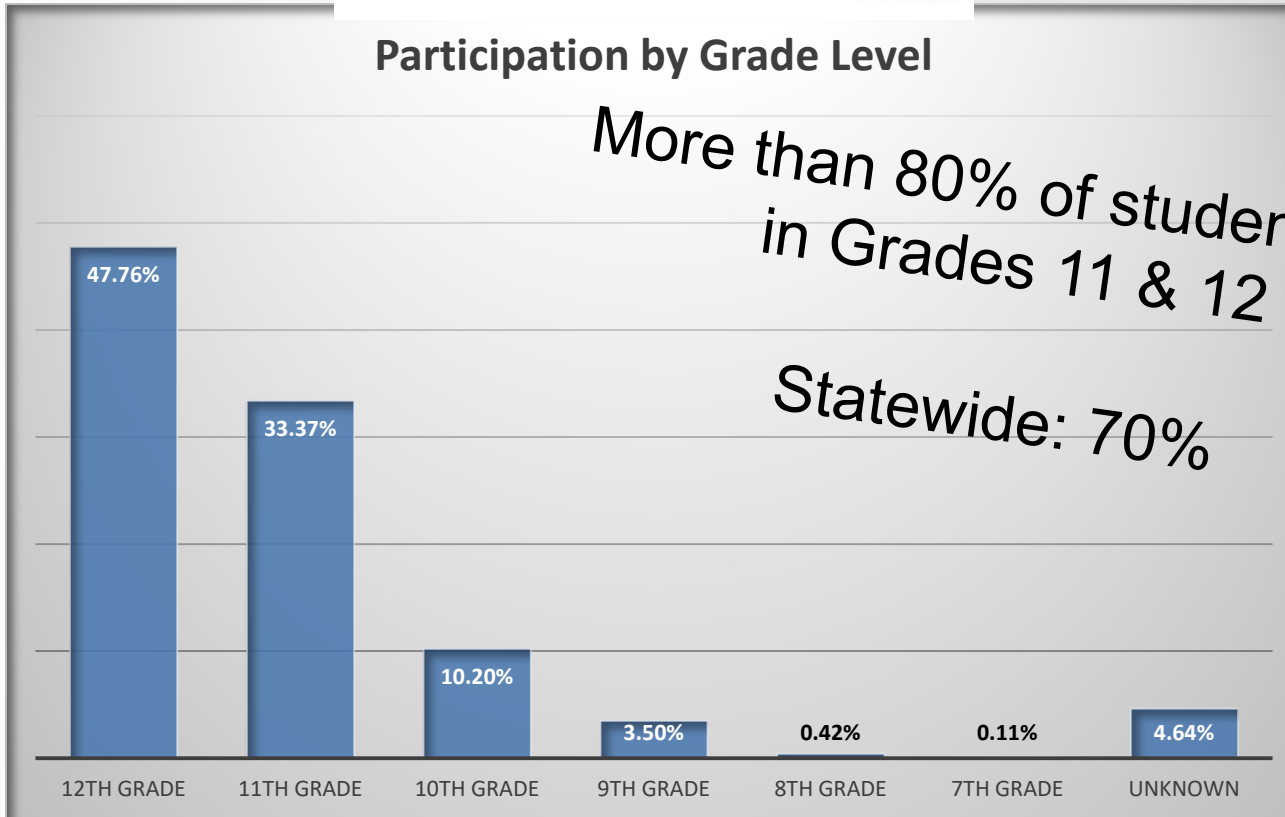


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Participation by Grade Level

in Grades 11 & 12

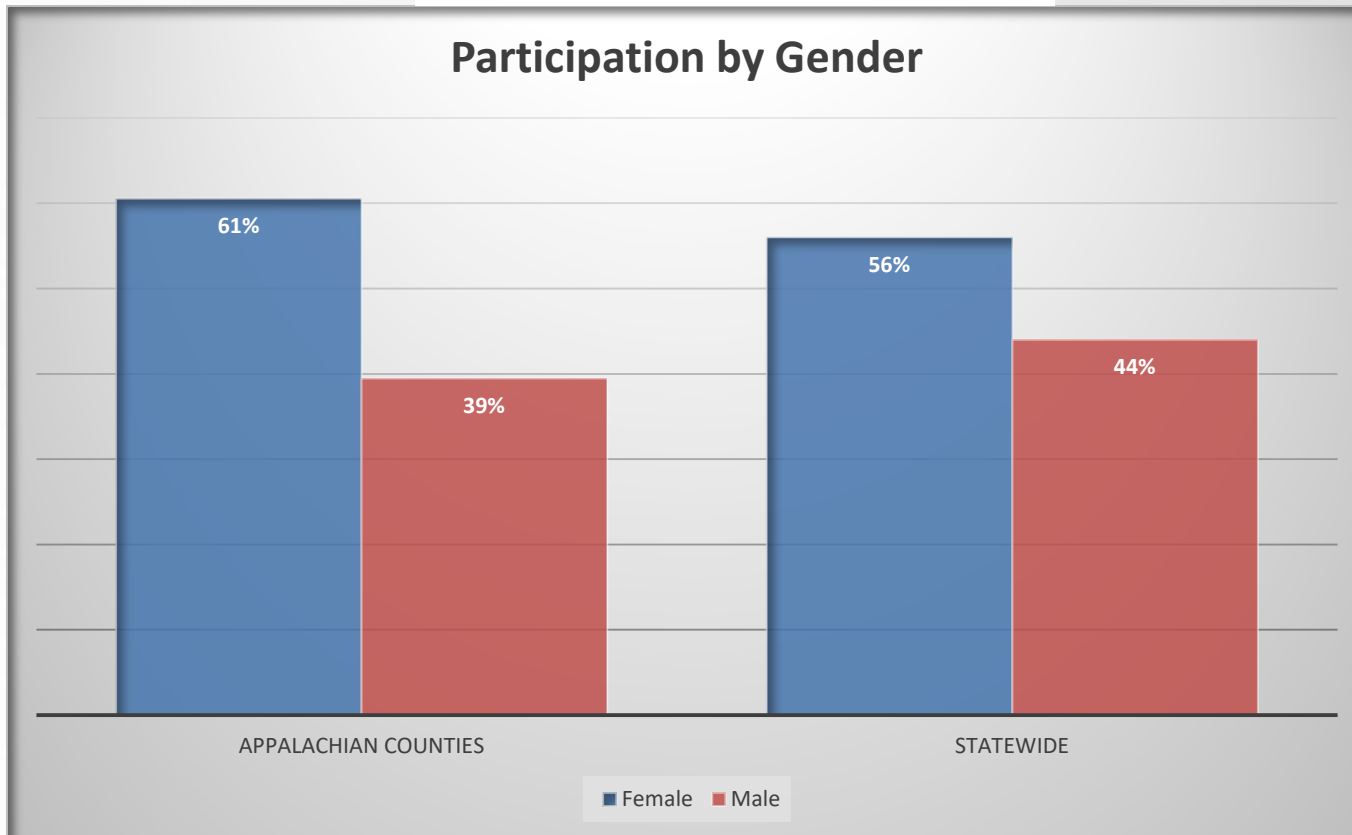

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Participation by Gender



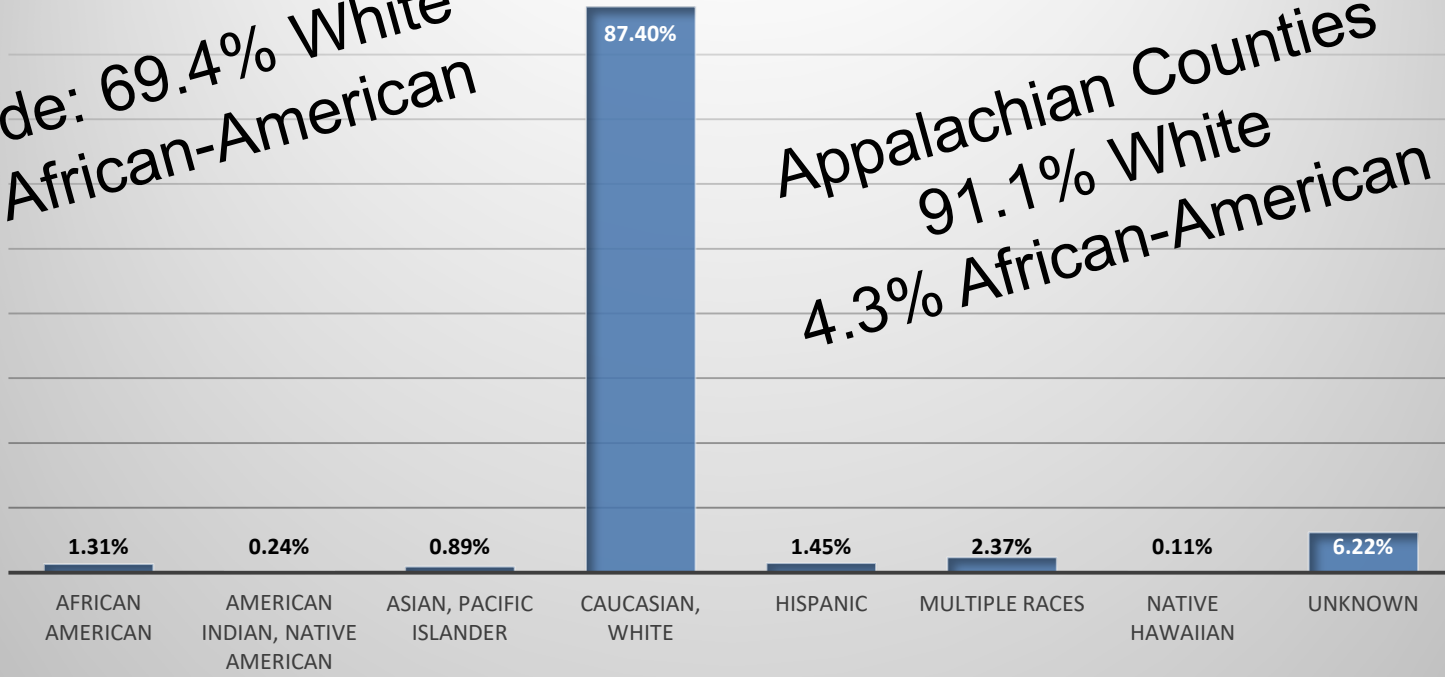


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Participation by Race

16.7% African-American

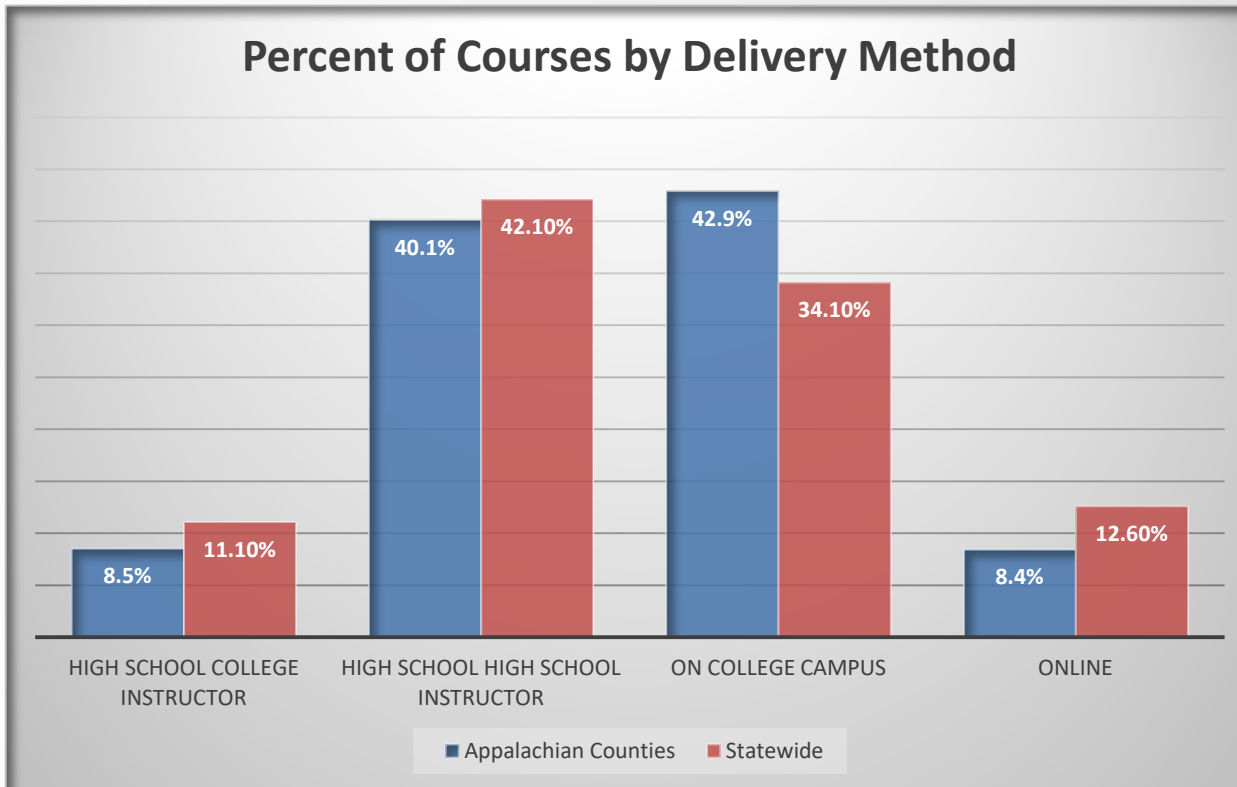
Appalachian Counties

4.3% African-American





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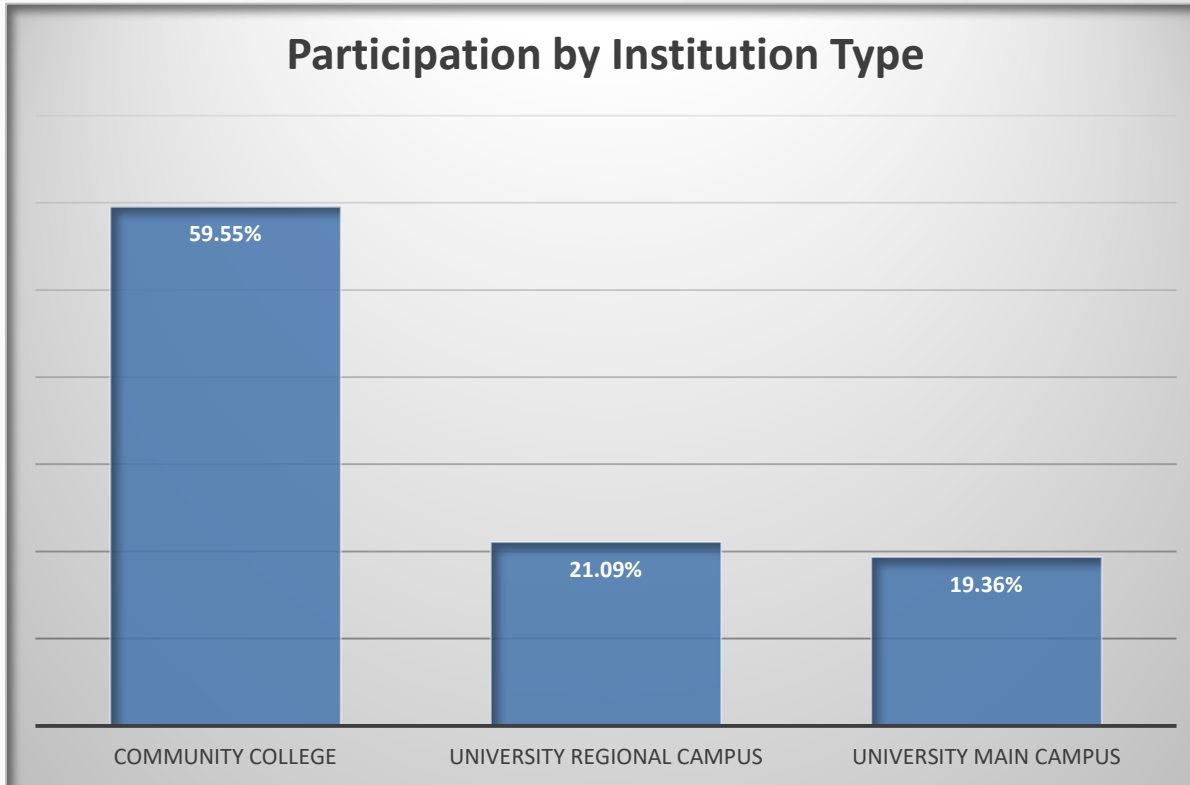
Percent of Courses by Delivery Method





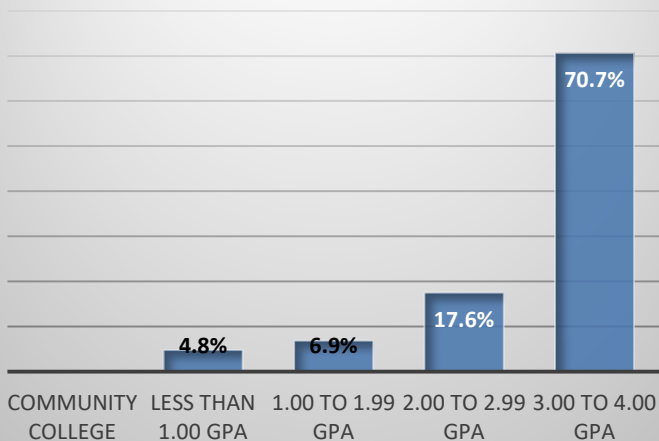

Participation by Institution Type

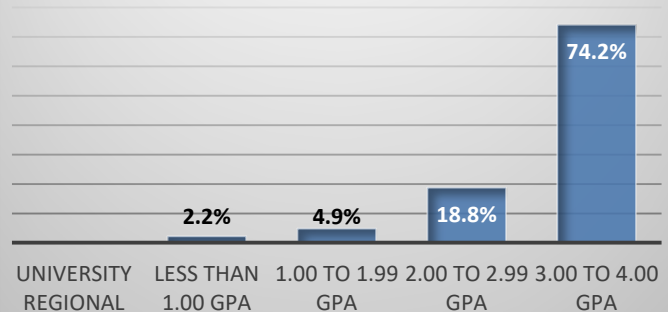




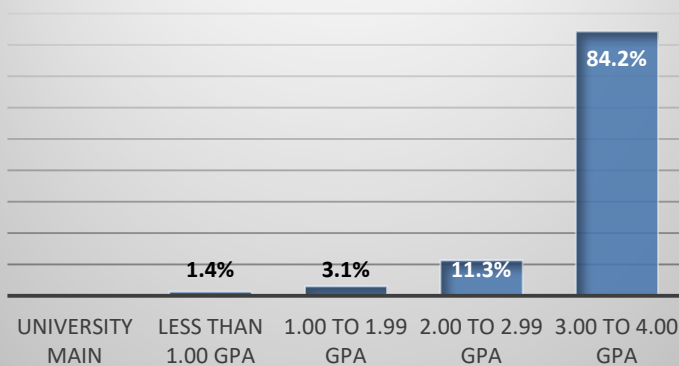
Community College - GPA

College Credit Plus

- Work to be considered
 - Increase access opportunities in Appalachian Ohio
 - Work with secondary schools and colleges/universities on policies and professional development
 - Follow cohort of students beyond high school to determine attainment rates, time-to-completion



College Credit Plus

- Work to be considered
 - 2018-2019: Changes to Student Eligibility, Course Eligibility, and Underperforming Students
 - 2019-2020: Policy changes in response to stakeholder feedback and additional data collection/analysis
